## Mr. K. Recognises The New Nation

MOSCOW, Aug. 31 (AP)—  
The Soviet Government  
has recognised Trinidad  
and Tobago and has ex-  
pressed readiness to  
establish diplomatic rela-  
tions, Tass announced to-  
day.

The Soviet news agency  
said Mr. Nikita Khrushchev  
sent a telegram to the  
Prime Minister-delegate  
of Trinidad and Tobago, Dr. Eric Williams, saying:

"As an ardent champion

of the immediate abolition

of colonialism, the peoples of the  
Soviet Union value the  
new independent State and  
with the people of Trinidad

and Tobago.

Williams said he was

invited to the Soviet Union

in September to receive

the award of the Order

of Friendship of Peoples.

The Soviet Ambassador  
in London, Mr. Anatoly

Kuznetsov, told his press  
conference yesterday he would  
have to meet Mr. Khrushchev

at the Soviet London assembly.
